Admin must follow the below steps to collect these two keys:

 Visit <u>https://developers.facebook.com/</u>. The admin will be redirected to the 'Facebook for Developers' page as shown in figure 2.

- 2. Click on the '**LogIn'** button (as marked in figure 2) to proceed further. Create an account (The admin may have to register as a developer).
- After logging in, the admin will be redirected to the homepage as shown in figure 3. The admin must click on the 'My Apps' button (as marked in figure 3) to proceed on to the next step.

- 6. Admin will then be redirected to '**Create an App Id**' form as shown in figure 6, in which admin must enter:
 - App Display Name: A new app name.
 - App Contact Email: Their valid email address to be linked with their account.
 - Do you have a Business Manager Account?: Select a Business Manager Account if already created. A new Business Manager Account can be created later as well.

After entering all the necessary details, the admin must click on the '**Create App Id**' button to proceed further.

 A 'Security Check' pop-up box will appear as shown in figure 7 in which the admin must complete the security check step and then click on the 'Submit' button.

NB: Nota Bene [Note Well] (N.B., N.b., n.b or NB, Nb, nb) is a Latin phrase, meaning 'note well' or 'take notice' or 'please note'. Asterisk (*) next to a form control's label indicates it as 'required'.

8. Admin will be redirected to '**Dashboard**'. From the side-navigation bar, the admin must go to '**Settings**' and then '**Basic**' as shown in figure 8.

As shown in figure 9, the '**Basic Settings**' page displays the '**App ID**' and '**App Secret**' keys. The admin must copy these keys and paste them in their settings as shown in <u>figure 1</u>.

NB: The admin must, however configure further settings to ensure that the plugin works correctly. To do so, please follow the below steps.

10. In "**App Domains**", the admin must add all the domains from which they want the Facebook login to work, i.e. all the marketplace domains. If the admin is moving between a Sharetribe subdomain and a custom domain, it's best to add both here to ensure that the Facebook login keeps working even when the domain changes. The domains must be added without "https" or "www" or "subdomain":



- For your **custom domain** (in the Pro/Growth/Scale plan), the domain could be: "<domainname>.com"
- For your **Sharetribe subdomain** (in a trial or Starter or Hobby plan), the domain could be: "<domainname>.sharetribe.com"
- 11. Admin must then click on the '**Add Platform**' button that is provided at the bottom when reaching the last segment of this form (Refer figure 10).

In 'Site URL', admin must add their full marketplace's URL with https and possibly www or the subdomain:

- If the admin is on a Pro/Growth/Scale plan, it could be: "<u>https://www.<domainname>.com</u>", "<u>https://<domainname>.com</u>", or "<u>https://something.mygreatmarketplace.com</u>".
- If the admin is on a trial, Starter or Hobby plan, it could be: <u>"https://<domainname>.sharetribe.com</u>"

Admin must then click on the 'Save Changes' button provided below.
